6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to recording; and providing for an
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.21.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:
10 (12) administer and maintain the recording system established
11 under the laws of this state.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 44.21 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 Sec. 44.21.060. RECORDING. (a) The department shall adopt regu-
14 lations establishing, modifying, or discontinuing recording districts or
15 precincts and prescribing the records to be maintained and the instru-
16 ments to be recorded.

17 (b) The department shall engage and compensate recorders and
18 deputy recorders, prescribe and account for recording fees, and do all
19 other things necessary to maintain the recording system established
20 under the laws of this state.

21 * Sec. 3. The recording districts established by the supreme court in
22 effect on the effective date of this Act shall remain in effect until regula-
23 tions establishing, modifying, or discontinuing recording districts or pre-
24 cincts have been adopted by the Department of Administration.

25 * Sec. 4. AS 22.05.160 is repealed.

26 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 1977.
