6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to parking facilities."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 29.33.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (c) If offstreet parking is required by a zoning regulation or  
10 provided in connection with a structure, a number of parking spaces re-  
11 lated to the traffic generated by the structure shall be required by the  
12 zoning regulation to be for the use of the general public without pay-  
13 ment of fees. If the applicable zoning regulation does not specify the  
14 percentage of parking for public use, at least one-half of the parking  
15 required or provided shall be for public use. This section does not  
16 apply to structures whose primary use is for parking facilities. No  
17 waiver of the requirements of this subsection may be granted under  
18 AS 35.10.020 for public works of this state.
