6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the presence of intoxicated persons
7 in taverns."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.025. PRESENCE OF INTOXICATED PERSONS IN ESTABLISHMENTS
11 WHICH SERVE INTOXICATING BEVERAGES. An intoxicated person may not enter
12 or remain in an establishment licensed under AS 04.10.040 - 04.10.070.
13 An intoxicated person who refuses to leave such an establishment upon
14 being instructed to leave by the owner or an employee is guilty of a
15 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than
16 \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 04.15.100(a) is amended to read:

18 (a) A person who violates any provision of this title other than
19 secs. 25 and [SEC.] 80 of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and
20 upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment of not more than one year,
21 or by a fine of not more than \$500. Each violation is a separate
22 offense.

23 * Sec. 3. AS 47.37.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

24 (c) Nothing in this chapter affects AS 04.15.025 relating to the
25 presence of intoxicated persons in establishments which serve intoxi-
26 cating beverages.
