6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to payment of overtime."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 23.10.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of (a) of this section limiting
10 an employee's workday to eight hours a day unless compensation is paid
11 at the overtime rate prescribed in that subsection, an employer may
12 employ an employee for 10 hours a day. However, in that event the
13 employee's workweek may not exceed four workdays, or 40 hours for that
14 week. If the employer finds it necessary to employ an employee in ex-
15 cess of 10 hours a day for four workdays, or in excess of 40 hours a
16 week, compensation for the overtime shall be paid as prescribed in (a)
17 of this section.
