For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to meat substitutes in meat served by
7 restaurants."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 03.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10

Sec. 03.05.025. MEAT SUBSTITUTES. (a) The commissioner shall
11 require that a restaurant, or other establishment where meat is prepared
12 for sale in meals or as entrees, may not serve meat which contains a
13 meat substitute unless it is clearly indicated in a prominent place on
14 the menu that the meat contains a meat substitute.

(b) For the purposes of this section "meat substitute" means any
16 substance which is not meat but does not include spices or other flavor-
17 ings, food colorings or food preservatives.
