6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to wage rates."

7 BBE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 36.05.010 is amended to read:

9           Sec. 36.05.010. WAGE RATES ON PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION. A contractor  
10 or subcontractor who performs work on public construction in the state,  
11 as defined by AS 36.95.010(3), shall pay not less than the current pre-  
12 vailing rate of wages for work of a similar nature in the region in  
13 which the work is done. The current prevailing rate of wages for each  
14 pay period is that contained in the latest determination of prevailing  
15 rate of wages issued by the Department of Labor before the end of the  
16 pay period.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 36.05.070(a) is amended to read:

18           (a) The advertised specifications for a public construction con-  
19 tract exceeding \$2,000 to which the state or a political subdivision of  
20 the state is a party which requires or involves the employment of  
21 mechanics, laborers, or field surveyors shall contain a provision  
22 stating the minimum wages to be paid various classes of laborers, mechan-  
23 ics, or field surveyors and that the rate of wages shall be adjusted to  
24 the wage rate for each pay period applicable under sec. 10 of this chap-  
25 ter.
