6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the design of license plates."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.130 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (b) After January 1, 1979, passenger vehicle plates provided in  
10 (a) of this section shall be fully reflective and display along with the  
11 Alaska flag the traditional colors of yellow-gold and blue.

12 (c) The commissioner of public safety shall sponsor a contest to  
13 select the slogan for the passenger vehicle permanent registration  
14 plates among Alaska's school children in grades 7 through 12 and shall  
15 select the slogan that best represents Alaska's history and hopes for  
16 the future. The commissioner shall reward the winner with a scholarship  
17 in the amount of \$500.

18 (d) The department may not adopt a new or altered design for the  
19 main plate under this section unless it substantially embodies the  
20 design selected by the commissioner under this Act.
