6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to guiding activity; and providing for
7 an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.54.040(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (8) establish a quota of licensed operating guides who may
12 operate within designated geographical game units or subunits of the
13 state and provide for an equitable and reasonable procedure for limiting
14 the number of guides to that quota. Preference shall be given to
15 qualified available and willing licensed guides who reside within
16 the designated game unit or subunit.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.240(4) is amended by adding a new subparagraph to
18 read:

19 (C) making a guaranty that a species or certain number
20 of species of game will be taken on a contract hunt.

21 * Sec. 3. AS 08.54.210(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

22 (6) a master or registered guide to employ or have under his
23 supervision more than three assistant guides at the same time.

24 * Sec. 4. AS 08.54.146 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 08.54.146. TRANSPORTER REPORT. A transporter shall maintain
26 a record of (1) the names and addresses of all persons he transports; (2)
27 the type of game transported; (3) an estimate of the quantity of meat
28 transported; (4) the date of transporting; and (5) if known, the locality
29 where the game was taken. The report shall be submitted to the Depart-

1 ment of Fish and Game within 90 [30] days after transporting the game.

2 After receiving a report required under this section, the Department of
3 Fish and Game shall send a copy of it to the Department of Public Safety.

4 * Sec. 5. Section 1 of this Act takes effect January 1, 1977. Section 4
5 of this Act takes effect on the effective date of Senate CS for CS for House
