7 of acting magistrates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.15.170(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) The presiding judge of the superior court in each judicial  
11 district shall appoint the magistrates for the district court for the  
12 judicial district, and may appoint acting magistrates as needed. An  
13 acting magistrate shall be a citizen of the United States and of the  
14 state, at least 21 years of age, but need not have established Alaska  
15 residence before his appointment. Each magistrate and acting magistrate  
16 serves at the pleasure of the presiding judge of the superior court in  
17 the judicial district for which appointed.
