(c) The presiding judge of the superior court in each judicial district shall appoint the magistrates for the district court for the judicial district, and may appoint acting magistrates. An acting magistrate shall be at least 21 years of age and a citizen of the United States and of the state. Alaskan residence shall be established before his appointment. Each magistrate and acting magistrate serves at the pleasure of the presiding judge of the superior court in the judicial district for which appointed.
