5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the selection of a capital site;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.06.150 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.06.150. CHOICE OF SITE BY VOTERS. The qualified voters of
11 Alaska are entitled to vote for any one of the alternate capital sites
12 selected by the capital selection committee at the next primary [GEN-
13 ERAL] election after conclusion of the public hearings. The site which
14 receives 50 per cent plus one vote of the votes cast will [RECEIVING THE
15 GREATER NUMBER OF VOTES SHALL] be the site of the new capital city. If
16 none of the sites receives 50 per cent plus one of the votes cast, the
17 two sites receiving the largest number of votes shall be placed on the
18 ballot at the next general election. The site which receives the major-
19 ity of the votes cast in that general election will be the site of the
20 new capital city.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 44.06.180 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 44.06.180. MOVEMENT TO NEW CAPITAL. The movement of the seat
23 of government to the new capital city shall begin not later than Octo-
24 ber 1, 1985 [1980].

25 * Sec. 3. (a) The provisions of sec. 2 of this Act are effective upon
26 certification by the lieutenant governor that the following referendum pro-
27 position has been approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on
28 the proposition at the next general election:

29 Proposition

1 Shall the provisions of sec. 2, ch. of the Session Laws
2 of Alaska of 1976, which amends Initiative Proposal No. 1,
3 1974, and provides for changing the date on which the
4 movement of the seat of government to the new capital city
5 shall begin from October 1, 1980 to October 1, 1985, be
6 approved?

9 (b) The lieutenant governor shall

10 (1) complete the blank in (a) of this section designating the
11 chapter number of this Act;

12 (2) make copies of this Act available to voters at the general
13 election in 1976; and

14 (3) as a part of the election pamphlet provided registered voters
15 under AS 15.57, include the summary and statements required under AS 15.57.-
16 010(2).

17 * Sec. 4. Sections 1 and 3 of this Act take effect immediately in accor-
18 dance with AS 01.10.070(c).
