6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the selection of a capital site."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 44.06.150 is amended to read:

9       Sec. 44.06.150. CHOICE OF SITE BY VOTERS. The qualified voters of  
10 Alaska are entitled to vote for any one of the alternate capital sites  
11 selected by the capital selection committee at the 1976 primary [NEXT  
12 GENERAL] election after conclusion of the public hearings. As an  
13 additional alternative, the ballot for that primary election shall  
14 include the words "none of the above", following the list of the three  
15 sites, and shall provide for voting for this alternative. The alterna-  
16 tive which receives 50 per cent plus one of the votes cast will [SITE  
17 RECEIVING THE GREATER NUMBER OF VOTES SHALL] be the site of the [NEW]  
18 capital city. If none of the alternatives receives 50 per cent plus one  
19 of the votes cast, the two which receive the largest number of votes  
20 shall be placed on the ballot for the 1976 general election. The alter-  
21 native which receives the majority of the votes cast in that general  
22 election will prevail.
