6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public school foundation
7 program; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.17.065. SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING. If in any prior
11 fiscal year, a school district or a regional educational attendance
12 area has expended an amount for electrical power that exceeds six per
13 cent of the area's or the district's total operational budget, then the
14 school district board or the regional school board may apply to the
15 Department of Education for reimbursement for the amount that exceeds
16 six per cent of the total operational budget. The funds shall be paid
17 to the school district or the regional educational attendance area from
18 any unallocated public school foundation program funds or other funds
19 available to the department.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
