6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public school foundation pro-
7 gram; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.021(c)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) K (minimum level of state support of basic need) = 95
11 [93] per cent;

12 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.021(c)(5) is amended to read:

13 (5) state aid as computed under this section constitutes at
14 least 95 [93] per cent of the basic need, as defined by the department,
15 of each school district.

16 * Sec. 3. AS 14.17.056 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 14.17.056. BASE INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT. (a) The base instruc-
18 tional unit for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976 [1975] and ending
19 June 30, 1977 [1976] is \$25,000 [\$23,500].

20 (b) The base instructional unit for fiscal years beginning on or
21 after July 1, 1977 [1976] is \$27,500 [\$25,000].

22 * Sec. 4. AS 14.17.051(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

23 (a) The instructional unit allotment for each school district or
24 regional educational attendance area is the base instructional unit
25 times the cost differential as determined by the formula $LCC/BCC \times$
26 $LCOL/BCOL$ where: (1) LCC is the cost of construction in the school
27 district or regional educational attendance area; (2) BCC is the cost
28 of construction in the school district or regional educational area
29 having the lowest cost of construction in the state; (3) LCOL means the

1 cost of living in the school district or regional educational atten-
2 dance area; (4) BCOL means the cost of living in the school district
3 or regional educational attendance area having the lowest cost of liv-
4 ing in the state. For purposes of this section, the Department of
5 Community and Regional Affairs shall annually determine the cost of
6 construction and the cost of living in each school district and regional
7 educational attendance area in the state under regulations promulgated
8 by the department establishing standards for the determination.

9 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
