6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to municipal powers to tax and license
7 for revenue the sale, possession, and manufacture of
8 intoxicating liquor."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.15.070(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) A municipality may by ordinance provide [RULES AND] regulations
12 governing the barter, sale and possession of intoxicating liquor within
13 the municipality necessary to the orderly conduct of the business of
14 selling intoxicating liquor. The ordinance may not be inconsistent
15 with this title or the [RULES AND] regulations promulgated under this
16 title. Provisions of AS 29.53 or charter notwithstanding, a municipal-
17 ity which provides an alcohol treatment program may tax and license for
18 revenue the sale, possession, or manufacture of intoxicating liquor;
19 however, the revenues to be raised by the taxes and licenses as esti-
20 ated by the chief executive officer of the municipality may not exceed
21 the total expenditures made or to be made by the municipality on alcohol
22 treatment programs and facilities in the immediately preceding fiscal
23 year, except that this limitation shall not apply to [NO MUNICIPALITY
24 MAY IMPOSE TAXES OTHER THAN] property taxes on liquor inventories and
25 sales taxes on liquor sales when these taxes are levied on other proper-
26 ty and sales within the municipality.
