6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to winery licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.10.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (o) winery license.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 04.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 04.10.095. WINERY LICENSE. The holder of a winery license
12 may operate a winery where wine may be produced, prepared and bottled
13 or barreled for sale. The holder of a winery license may sell wine to
14 any person holding a license authorizing the sale of wine. The holder
15 of a winery license also may sell wine produced by him to consumers for
16 consumption on or off the premises where sold and may sell food for
17 consumption on or off the premises where sold. A winery license also
18 authorizes the person to whom it is issued to conduct winetastings of
19 wine produced or bottled by him on or off his premises. The winery
20 license fee is \$100.
