6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to recruitment of workers for jobs in
7 Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.80.257. RECRUITMENT OF ALASKA WORKERS. (a) A corpora-
11 tion, partnership, labor organization, employment agency, or any other
12 person or organization offering to hire, test, process, or in any way
13 recruit workers for employment in Alaska shall provide that the recruit-
14 ment take place at the home rule municipality or first class city
15 located nearest the job site.

16 (b) A corporation, partnership, labor organization, employment
17 agency, or any other person or organization recruiting workers for
18 employment in Alaska who restricts recruitment solely to locations
19 other than the location specified in (a) shall

20 (1) provide notice of such recruitment in the five most
21 populous municipalities in the state by publishing notice of recruit-
22 ment three days a week for three consecutive weeks in at least one
23 daily newspaper of general circulation published in each municipality;

24 (2) provide job applicants with transportation expenses,
25 including room and board, from the applicant's Alaska residence to the
26 location where the recruitment is occurring, except that when recruit-
27 ment is occurring at two or more locations the job applicant may
28 choose where he is to be recruited from among the available locations.
