6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting discriminatory hiring practices in
7 recruitment of workers for jobs in Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.80.257. RECRUITMENT OF ALASKA WORKERS. (a) A corpora-
11 tion, partnership, labor organization, employment agency, or any other
12 person offering to hire, test, process, or in any way recruit workers
13 for employment in Alaska shall provide that recruitment take place at a
14 home rule municipality or first class city located within 600 miles of
15 the job site.

16 (b) If additional recruitment sites are provided which do not
17 comply with the provisions of (a) of this section, it is unlawful for a
18 person recruiting workers to discriminate in hiring against applicants
19 who apply at the site required by (a) of this section.

20 (c) If, following a hearing conducted in accordance with the
21 provisions of this chapter, the commission determines that discrimina-
22 tory hiring in violation of (b) of this section has occurred, the com-
23 mission may, in addition to the enforcement measures authorized by this
24 chapter, order the person found to be in violation of (b) of this sec-
25 tion to provide each job applicant with transportation, including room
26 and board, to and from the applicant's Alaska residence and the recruit-
27 ment site where job applicants have been granted an unlawful preference
28 in hiring.
