6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a collective bargaining unit for state
7 law enforcement officers and related personnel; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.40.090 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 23.40.090. COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT. Except as provided by
12 secs. 2 and 3 of this Act, the [THE] labor relations agency shall decide
13 in each case, in order to assure to employees the fullest freedom in
14 exercising the rights guaranteed by secs. 70 - 260 of this chapter, the
15 unit appropriate for the purposes of collective bargaining, based on
16 such factors as community of interest, wages, hours and other working
17 conditions of the employees involved, the history of collective bar-
18 gaining, and the desires of the employees. Bargaining units shall be as
19 large as is reasonable, and unnecessary fragmenting shall be avoided.

20 * Sec. 2. A collective bargaining unit is hereby established which is
21 composed of the following personnel classifications presently represented by
22 the general government unit: commissioned officers in the Department of
23 Public Safety and airport police, and correctional officers, admissions of-
24 ficers, probation officers, youth counselors and psychological counselors
25 within the division of corrections.

26 * Sec. 3. An election shall be held for the purpose of determining col-
27 lective bargaining representation 30 days from the effective date of this Act.

28 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
29 070(c).
