5 Amending Rule 13 of the Uniform Rules
6 of the Alaska State Legislature by
7 providing a nonvoting chair on the
8 floor of each house for the Executive
9 Branch of government.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. RULE 13, UNIFORM RULES, ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE, is amended
12 to read:

13 RULE 13. (a) No person not a member of the house is permitted on
14 the floor of the house chamber while the house is sitting or in brief
15 recess unless he is a member of the other house or an officer or an
16 employee authorized to be present by the presiding officer or he occupies
17 the executive branch chair provided for in (b) of this rule. The pre-
18 siding officer may extend the privilege of the floor to former legis-
19 lators and distinguished visitors for the day but not for the purpose
20 of discussion and debate. No one but a member of the legislature or an
21 occupant of the executive branch chair may advocate or oppose passage
22 of a bill or resolution in the chamber of the house while the house is
23 in session.

24 (b) A chair shall be provided on the floor of each house for the
25 use of the governor or a member of his cabinet. An occupant of the
26 executive branch chair shall have all privileges extended to members of
27 the house except the right to cast a vote on any question before the
28 house.
