5 Commending Colonel M. E. Dankworth.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Colonel M. E. Dankworth, director of the Alaska State Troopers,  
8 has announced his retirement, effective February 16, 1975; and

9 WHEREAS, for the past 21 years, Colonel Dankworth has concerned himself  
10 with the humane enforcement of the laws of Alaska while at the same time  
11 advocating and implementing sophisticated practices and methods relating to  
12 the detection and prosecution of criminal activities, all with the viewpoint  
13 of making Alaska a safer and better place to live; and

14 WHEREAS his integrity, cooperation, knowledge and leadership capabilities  
15 have long been acknowledged by law enforcement and judicial leaders alike; and

16 WHEREAS his many accomplishments and honors associated with his work as  
17 a law enforcement officer over the past 21 years are literally too numerous

19 WHEREAS Colonel Dankworth is retiring and will take with him the greatest  
20 honor that could be bestowed upon him, namely, the unqualified respect for him  
21 as a dedicated and devoted officer;

23 regrets at the loss to the state Colonel Dankworth's retirement will mean, but  
24 extends its most heartfelt thanks for a job well done, and extends its very  
25 best wishes for continued success in all of his future endeavors.
