7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 calendar year, enjoying its 25th anniversary; and

10 WHEREAS this travel and recreational association's activities during
11 the past 25 years have provided a high quality of leadership and activity
12 for the general good of thousands of Alaskans throughout the state over

15 group were held in Juneau, Alaska, November 4, 1950, and in Anchorage,
