2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to wolf control in certain areas.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the Department of Fish and Game has announced plans for an
8 aerial hunting control program designed to reduce the wolf population in
9 Unit 20A; and

10 WHEREAS, even with the program as outlined, normal production of the
11 remaining wolves and immigration into Unit 20A may make it necessary for
12 several years to maintain control of the wolf population; and

13 WHEREAS control of the wolf population in the designated area is essen-
14 tial to the protection of and gradual buildup of the existing moose popula-
15 tion; and

16 WHEREAS Units 20B and 20C connect with 20A, and the problems that exist
17 in 20A are also evident in these other areas; and

18 WHEREAS it would seem desirable that the wolf control program be ex-
19 panded, assuming the department's evidence so indicates, to all of Unit 20
20 and not be limited to 20A;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Department of
22 Fish and Game is urged to consider expansion of the announced wolf control
23 program and to issue permits to qualified persons to take wolves in Units 20B
24 and C when the department determines there is a need for an areawide wolf
25 control program.
