Relating to training in nonaggressive self-

defense in secondary schools of the state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, with the high incidence of violent crimes against individuals,

9

there is a need for public high schools to include as part of their physical

10

education program training in nonaggressive self-defense; and

11

WHEREAS, if persons were better able to defend themselves, they would be

12

less vulnerable to rape and other violent bodily assaults;

13

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governing board

14

of each school district maintaining a high school is respectfully requested

15

to ascertain the need for offering physical education classes in nonaggressive

16

self-defense and if a need exists, to report to the Department of Education by

17

July 1, 1976, what action, if any, has been taken; and be it

18

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is respectfully re-

19

quested to work with and assist school districts, including the state

20

operated school system, in developing programs in nonaggressive self-defense;

21

and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the department submit a summary and evaluation of

23

the findings by the various school districts together with a progress report

24

on the implementation of such programs to the Tenth Legislature - First

25

Session.
