SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 19

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to special investigative units
for cases involving sexual offenses.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS most law enforcement agencies have inadequately staffed and
trained investigative units for cases involving sexual offenses; and

WHEREAS when special investigative units for cases involving sexual
offenses have been established, the evidence indicates the investigations are
more thorough and effective; and

WHEREAS special units for the investigation of repeated sexual offenses
would be particularly effective if employed in areas with a known high in-
cidence of sexual assaults;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Alaska Police
Standards Council is respectfully requested to develop a plan for the train-
ing of specialists to investigate charges of rape and other sexual assaults
and to encourage local law enforcement agencies to develop special investi-
gative units for cases involving sexual assaults.
