3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the mandatory retirement of
6 persons attaining a certain age.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state that no human resource
9 be wasted; and

10 WHEREAS many of our citizens over the age of 65 are capable and desirous
11 of continuing contributions to society through employment and business acti-
12 vities; and

13 WHEREAS these same citizens often find themselves forced into retirement
14 at a time which is both inconvenient and unrealistic, with the concomitant
15 difficulty of obtaining credit while unemployed; and

16 WHEREAS the problems of the aged and the aging are of great concern
17 to the people of Alaska;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
19 respectfully requested to direct the State Commission for Human Rights to
20 study the effects of prohibiting forced retirement based solely upon an
21 arbitrary age and submit its report to the Governor and the Legislative
22 Council as part of the Commission's annual report on December 31, 1975.
