2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 56

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to utilization of pipeline camps.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS, under the pipeline leases from both the United States and the
8 State of Alaska, Alyeska Pipeline Company is now required to restore the land
9 they have impacted by construction-related activities when the pipeline is
10 completed; and

11 WHEREAS, in the process of construction, Alyeska has developed substan-
12 tial pipeline camps; and

13 WHEREAS these camps would be of value to the state for many purposes,
14 including recreational purposes, and would be of extreme value in the con-
15 struction of the gas pipeline; and

16 WHEREAS the state, by agreement with Alyeska Pipeline Company, should
17 assume the responsibility Alyeska currently has to restore the land so that
18 the state may preserve the pipeline camps for other uses;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor, through the Department of Natural
20 Resources or such other department as he may consider desirable, is respect-
21 fully requested to enter into negotiations with Alyeska Pipeline Company to
22 acquire the pipeline camps constructed by Alyeska, and to enter into negotia-
23 tions with the United States to secure agreement from the federal government
24 that the pipeline camps be retained and devoted to uses beneficial to the
25 state.
