2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 61

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to assistance of the Legislature
6 at the tenth annual Boys' State.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the tenth annual Boys' State program will be held on the
9 campus and facilities of the University of Alaska at Fairbanks, Alaska,
10 June 6 - 12, 1976; and

11 WHEREAS at Boys' State the delegates learn the duties of the various
12 offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

13 WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the
14 election of a legislature and the introduction and debate upon bills in
15 accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

16 WHEREAS the Legislature, as in past years, could be of valuable aid to
17 the operation of the Boys' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs
18 Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legisla-
19 tive process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members
20 in attendance at Boys' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative
21 program;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature directs the Legislative
23 Council to authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency, within the limits of
24 its appropriations, to assist in the preparation of legislative materials
25 and, on the request of the Boys' State director, to have legislators desig-
26 nated by the presiding officer of each house and two Agency staff members
27 attend the tenth annual Boys' State to aid the delegates in the legislative
28 program.
