4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Urging the Department of Highways to main-
6 tain public access to the Chugach State
7 Park.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Chugach State Park provides winter recreational opportunities
10 for the citizens of the entire Anchorage area; and

11 WHEREAS major winter recreational uses within the park are cross-country
12 skiing and snowmachining; and

13 WHEREAS access to these recreational areas within the park are over pri-
14 vately maintained roads, specifically Upper Huffman Road entrance to the
15 snowmobile staging area and the Upper O'Malley entrances via Prospect Drive
16 and Trails End Road; and

17 WHEREAS the burden of maintaining these roads is presently being born
18 entirely by the residents of the area served by the roads; and

19 WHEREAS the Anchorage Borough Assembly, on October 28, 1975, passed a
20 resolution urging state maintenance of this public access;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
22 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to assume its
23 responsibility for maintaining the public's access to the entrances to
24 Chugach State Park.
