2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 69

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting the Board of Game to establish  
6 game sanctuaries on all military reserva-  
7 tions in Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Board of Game has the authority to establish game sanctu-  
10 aries in the waters or on the lands of the state over which it has jurisdic-  
11 tion, subject to the approval of the Legislature; and

12 WHEREAS recreational access is already severely limited on military  
13 reservations so that sanctuary establishment there will not unduly burden  
14 Alaskans; and

15 WHEREAS additional sanctuaries with no hunting permitted will provide  
16 natural areas for game populations to stabilize and replenish the adjacent  
17 lands not on reservations; and

18 WHEREAS, in recent official communications with the state, the Depart-  
19 ment of Defense has demonstrated its serious concern for the wildlife in  
20 these areas;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
22 the Board of Game, at its spring board meeting, to establish game sanctu-  
23 aries on all military reservations in Alaska under the jurisdiction of the  
24 Department of Defense, whose boundaries coincide with those of the reserva-  
25 tions.
