5 Requesting the Legislative Council to
6 appoint a task force to study reorganiza-
7 tion of the food and drug laws.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS changes in the Federal laws controlling drug distribution have
10 resulted in a confusing and often duplicative approach to control of the
11 legitimate manufacturing, distribution and use of drugs and to enforcement
12 against illicit drug traffic; and

13 WHEREAS all citizens of the state as well as the professionals charged
14 with the responsibility for administering and upholding the laws relating
15 to drugs would be greatly benefitted by a restructuring of Alaska food and
16 drug laws;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Legislative
18 Council is requested to appoint a task force to study the food and drug laws,
19 including in the task force membership representatives of the Board of
20 Pharmacy, Alaska Pharmaceutical Association, Alaska Medical Association,
21 Alaska Nurses Association, Alaska Dental Society, and Department of Law; the
22 task force is to deliver its report and legislative recommendations to the
23 First Session of the Tenth Legislature.
