7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS during the legislative session the volume of public interest and  
9 inquiries on legislative activities is extremely high; and

10 WHEREAS information on many activities of both the Senate and House is  
11 not immediately available for public response; and

12 WHEREAS the cost of a toll-free telephone service would be tremendously  
13 outweighed by the benefits of public input to the legislative process;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature directs the Legislative  
15 Council to establish a toll-free telephone service in Juneau, enabling  
16 anyone in the State of Alaska to call at no charge to contact his legislator  
17 or to obtain legislative information.
