5 Establishing a toll-free telephone "hot
6 line" within the legislature.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS during the legislative session the volume of public interest and
9 inquiries on legislative activities is extremely high; and

10 WHEREAS information on many activities of both the Senate and House is
11 not immediately available for public response; and

12 WHEREAS the cost of a toll-free telephone service would be tremendously
13 outweighed by the benefits of public input to the legislative process;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature directs the Legislative
15 Council to study the feasibility of establishing a toll-free telephone
16 service in Juneau, enabling anyone in the State of Alaska to call at no
17 charge to contact his legislator or to obtain legislative information. The
18 study and its recommendations shall be presented to the legislature no later
19 than January 10, 1977.
