5 Relating to competitive bidding for state
6 contracts.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the high cost of doing business in Alaska puts the Alaska
9 business community in a difficult competitive position in relation to busi-
10 nesses outside the state for bidding on state contracts; and

11 WHEREAS the five per cent Alaska bidder preference in AS 37.05.230(1) is
12 not sufficient to put Alaska bidders in an equal competitive position with
13 bidders from other states; and

14 WHEREAS the interest of all Alaskans is served by encouraging the
15 development of the Alaska business community;

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully
17 requests the Governor to direct the Department of Administration, Division of
18 General Services and Supply, to conduct a study for the purpose of finding a
19 solution to the dilemma faced by the Alaska business community in regard to
20 competitive bidding.
