6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the members of the Alaska State Legislature are saddened to  
8 learn of the sudden death of James R. McKeown, whose friendship and leader-  
9 ship in business will be missed by all who knew and worked with him; and

10 WHEREAS Jim, born in Tacoma, Washington, was a graduate of the University  
11 of Portland; first working with Boeing as an industrial engineer and then  
12 serving Alaska's Department of Revenue before entering the insurance business;

14 WHEREAS Jim's business leadership and abilities were recognized by his  
15 election last October as president of Rollins Burdick Hunter of Alaska, Inc.,  
16 after serving with the firm and its predecessor, LaBow, Haynes of Alaska,  
17 Inc.; and

18 WHEREAS Jim was active in many community activities including the  
19 Anchorage Rotary Club, the Petroleum Club, YMCA, the Anchorage Raquet Club  
20 and has been a member of the Anchorage Chamber of Commerce executive commit-  
21 tee since 1974;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it expresses its  
23 most sincere sorrow at the passing of Jim McKeown, recognizing his tireless  
24 service to his business, community and family.
