Relating to proposed regulations to

6

restrict the sale of handgun ammunition.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission currently

9

has under consideration a proposal to restrict handgun ammunition as a

10

hazardous substance such as dynamite under the Consumer Product Safety Act;

11

and

WHEREAS the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has taken the position

13

that the proposed regulation is not in the best interest of Alaskans; and

14

WHEREAS such a regulation would adversely affect thousands of Alaskans

15

from every walk of life; and

16

WHEREAS it is vital that the proposed regulation not be enacted;

17

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it vigorously opposes

18

any attempt to classify handgun ammunition as a hazardous substance and

19

urgently requests the Consumer Product Safety Commission to totally reject the

20

proposal.
