9 of providing the members of the Legislature with copies of their publications.
10 This service has enabled legislators to maintain contact with their home
11 communities and allowed legislators from elsewhere to broaden their awareness
12 of events in and sentiments of citizens in communities not their own. The
13 availability of these newspapers has also permitted members to be aware of
14 the quality of the wire service and special correspondent coverage of legis-
15 lative and other governmental activities at the capital.
