6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the legislative appropriation pro-  
7 cess."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 37.07.070 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 37.07.070. LEGISLATIVE REVIEW. The legislature shall con-  
11 sider the governor's proposed comprehensive program and financial plan,  
12 evaluate alternatives to the plan, make program selections among the  
13 various alternatives and determine, subject to available revenues, the  
14 level of funding required to support authorized state services. During  
15 each regular session of the legislature, not later than the 60th legis-  
16 lative day, each house shall have calendared for second reading a  
17 version of the general appropriations Act. The bill shall be supported  
18 with documentation to explain the proposed appropriations and related  
19 statements of intent. In addition, a list of other appropriations or  
20 measures with fiscal implications pending before the legislature shall  
21 be included with the documentation for the calendared bill. At the end  
22 of the 60th legislative day, if the bill has not been before both houses  
23 on second reading, then the version of the bill in committee, supported  
24 with documentation to explain the proposed appropriations and related  
25 statements of intent, shall be discharged from committee and placed on  
26 the calendar for vote on second reading on the 61st legislative day.  
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
