6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to workmen's compensation death bene-
7 fits."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.215 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (e) Total compensation paid under this section may not exceed
11 \$200,000 except as provided in (f) of this section.

12 (f) Monetary limitations of this section notwithstanding, a sur-
13 viving widow or widower who was dependent upon the deceased employee at
14 the time of death and incapable of self-support by reason of mental or
15 physical disability or otherwise not employable, as determined by the
16 board, and who has not remarried shall continue to receive death benefits
17 until this condition changes or until death.
