6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.10.200 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 04.10.200. PUBLIC NOTICE. The board shall provide by regula-
10 tion for adequate notice to inform the public and the local governing
11 body of a proposed issuance of a new license [, RENEWAL] or transfer of
12 an existing license. The notice shall be bilingual when necessary.
13 Notice shall be given by posting at the location of the premises, at the
14 nearest post office, and at one other conspicuous location in the area
15 for a period of at least 10 days a true copy of the application and by
16 publishing notice, in a form approved by the board, of the intention to
17 acquire or transfer a license. The notice shall be published four times
18 during four consecutive calendar weeks, once in each week, in a news-
19 paper published in the area in which the issuance or transfer is pending
20 or, if no newspaper is published in the area, then in a newspaper cir-
21 culating in the state that is distributed in that area [PUBLIC SERVICE
22 ANNOUNCEMENTS PROVIDED TO NEWSPAPERS AND RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS
23 AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE FILING THE APPLICATION].
