6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to earlier service retirement credit  
7 for territorial employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.35.360(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) An employee who completes three years of service with the  
11 state after January 1, 1961, for which he makes contributions required  
12 by this chapter is entitled to service credit for employment rendered to  
13 the State and former Territory of Alaska before January 1, 1961, regard-  
14 less of the office, department, division, or agency of the state or  
15 territory in which he was employed, including service as a commissioned  
16 officer of the United States Public Health Service, the United States  
17 District Court and the United States Commissioner's Court serving the  
18 Territory and State of Alaska succeeded to by the Alaska court system,  
19 persons employed as United States marshals, United States deputy mar-  
20 shals, Civil Aeronautics Administration security guards and heavy equip-  
21 ment operators, United States Corps of Engineers security guards, and  
22 employees of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, the Alaska  
23 Road Commission, the [AND] Bureau of Public Roads and the Alaska Jail  
24 System of the United States Department of Justice. The retirement  
25 benefits payable to an employee under this section which are attributable  
26 to employment rendered to the State and former Territory of Alaska  
27 before January 1, 1961, shall be reduced by the amount of the retirement  
28 pension benefits paid to him by the United States government for the  
29 same period of service.
