6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to stream surveillance for fisheries
7 violations."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 ARTICLE 10. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 16.10.570. STREAM SURVEILLANCE. A person employed with the
12 Department of Public Safety on a temporary basis as a "stream guard" or
13 member of a "stake-out crew" for the purpose of stream surveillance and
14 the apprehension of commercial fishing violators shall, to the maximum
15 extent possible under the circumstances, remain visible and unconcealed
16 while on duty at his assigned duty station.
