6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Public Employment Relations
7 Act; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 23.40.245. POSTSECONDARY STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN COLLECTIVE

11 BARGAINING. (a) When a bargaining unit includes members of the faculty
12 of a public institution of postsecondary education, the employer or his
13 designated representative and the representative of the bargaining unit
14 shall permit the members of a postsecondary education student committee,
15 selected under (c) of this section, to

16 (1) attend and observe all meetings between the employer or
17 his designated representative and the representative of the bargaining
18 unit which are involved with collective bargaining;

19 (2) comment in good faith during the meetings upon the
20 matters under consideration; and

21 (3) have access to all written documents pertaining to col-
22 lective bargaining exchanged by the employer or his designated represen-
23 tative and the representative of the bargaining unit, including copies
24 of any prepared written transcripts of the meetings.

25 (b) Members of the postsecondary education student committee may
26 not disclose any information concerning the substance of any collective
27 bargaining obtained by the members in the course of their activities
28 under (a) of this section, unless that information is released by either
29 the employer, his representative, or the representative of the bargain-

1 ing unit.

2 (c) For the purposes of this section, the Board of Regents of the
3 University of Alaska shall divide the state into three regions. The
4 three members of the postsecondary education student committee shall be
5 selected by a student executive officers council created in each of the
6 three regions. The student executive council for a region shall consist
7 of the executive officer of each elected student government organization
8 recognized by the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska within
9 that region. The student executive officers council of each region
10 shall choose one member to represent it on the postsecondary education
11 student committee. If a regional student executive officers council
12 does not exist for each of the three regions, those regions which do
13 have such a council shall choose a representative for the region or
14 regions without such a council.

15 (d) The members of the postsecondary education student committee
16 need not be students.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
18 070(c).
