6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Public Employment Relations
7 Act; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 23.40.245. POSTSECONDARY STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN COLLECTIVE

11 BARGAINING. (a) When a bargaining unit includes members of the faculty
12 of a public institution of postsecondary education, the employer or his
13 designated representative and the representative of the bargaining unit
14 shall permit the members of a postsecondary education student committee,
15 selected under (c) of this section, to

16 (1) attend and observe all meetings between the employer or
17 his designated representative and the representative of the bargaining
18 unit which are involved with collective bargaining;

19 (2) have access to all written documents pertaining to col-
20 lective bargaining exchanged by the employer or his designated represen-
21 tative and the representative of the bargaining unit, including copies
22 of any prepared written transcripts of the meetings.

23 (b) Members of the postsecondary education student committee may
24 not disclose any information concerning the substance of any collective
25 bargaining obtained by the members in the course of their activities
26 under (a) of this section, unless that information is released by either
27 the employer, his representative, or the representative of the bargain-
28 ing unit, or an impasse is declared by the labor relations agency.

29 (c) The governor shall appoint three students of the University

of Alaska as the members of the postsecondary education student committee. No more than two student members may be from the same campus.
