7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 22.15.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 22.15.040. SMALL CLAIMS. When a claim for relief does not
10 exceed \$2,000 [\$1,000] exclusive of costs, interest and attorney fees,
11 and request is so made, the district judge or magistrate shall hear the
12 action as a small claim unless important or unusual points of law are
13 involved. The supreme court shall prescribe the procedural rules and
14 standard forms to assure simplicity and the expeditious handling of
15 small claims.
