6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Governors of the  
7 Alaska Bar."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.08.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The board consists of seven [NINE] active members elected by  
11 the active members of the Alaska Bar, and two laypersons appointed by  
12 the governor.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.08.050 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 08.08.050. SELECTION [ELECTION] OF THE BOARD. (a) Two mem-  
15 bers of the board shall be elected by and from among the members of the  
16 association resident in the first judicial district; two [FOUR] members  
17 of the board shall be elected by and from among the members of the  
18 association resident in the third judicial district; two members by and  
19 from among the members of the association resident in the combined area  
20 of the second and fourth judicial districts; [AND] one member at large  
21 from the entire state; and two laypersons appointed by the governor from  
22 the entire state.

23 (b) Members of the Board of Governors shall hold office for three  
24 years and until their successors are selected [ELECTED] and qualified.

25 (c) Three board members shall be selected [ELECTED] annually, on  
26 the following triennial rotation:

27 (1) in the first year, one member at large and two members  
28 from the third judicial district;

29 (2) in the second year, one member from the combined area of

1 the second and fourth judicial districts, one layperson appointed by the  
2 governor [MEMBER FROM THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT], and one member from  
3 the first judicial district; and

4 (3) in the third year, one member from the first judicial  
5 district, one member from the combined area of the second and fourth  
6 judicial districts, and one layperson appointed by the governor [MEMBER  
7 FROM THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT].
