6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the penalty for a felony committed  
7 while on release."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 12.30.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) A person released under this chapter in connection with a  
11 charge of felony, or while awaiting sentence or pending appeal after  
12 conviction of a felony offense, who commits a felony while on release  
13 is, upon conviction for the later offense, punishable as provided in AS  
14 12.55.055.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 12.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

16 Sec. 12.55.055. INCREASED PUNISHMENT FOR FELONY COMMITTED WHILE ON  
17 RELEASE. A person released under AS 12.30.020 or 12.30.040 in connec-  
18 tion with a charge of felony who, while on release, commits a felony is,  
19 upon conviction for that later offense, punishable as provided by law,  
20 except that the court shall impose a minimum sentence of imprisonment of  
21 not less than five years. The execution of sentence may not be sus-  
22 pended nor may probation or parole be granted until the minimum imprison-  
23 ment provided in this section has been served, nor may imposition of  
24 sentence be suspended except upon the condition that the defendant be  
25 imprisoned for no less than the minimum period provided in this section,  
26 nor may the punishment provided for in this section be reduced under AS  
27 11.05.150.
