7 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employment of nonresidents by the
8 state and its municipalities."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.40.210 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 23.40.210. AGREEMENT. Upon the completion of negotiations
12 between an organization and a public employer, if a settlement is
13 reached, the employer shall reduce it to writing in the form of an
14 agreement. The agreement may include a term for which it will remain in
15 effect, not to exceed three years. The agreement shall include a pay
16 plan designed to provide for a cost-of-living differential between the
17 salaries paid employees residing in the state and employees residing out-
18 side the state. The plan shall provide that the salaries paid, as of the
19 effective date of this Act, to employees residing outside the state shall
20 remain unchanged until the difference between those salaries and the
21 salaries paid employees residing in the state reflects the difference
22 between the cost of living in Alaska and living in Seattle, Washington.
23 The agreement shall include a grievance procedure which shall have
24 binding arbitration as its final step. Either party to the agreement
25 has a right of action to enforce the agreement by petition to the labor
26 relations agency.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act shall be implemented in the collective bargaining
28 agreements which replace the collective bargaining agreements in effect or
29 being negotiated as of the effective date of this Act.
