7 tional unit allotments."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 *Section 1. AS 14.17.041 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (a) The instructional unit allotment for each school district or
10 regional educational attendance area is as follows:

11 (1) if the district or area is in that part of the state
12 lying within the boundaries of election district 1, 4 or 8, the district
13 or area shall receive the base instructional allotment;

14 (2) if the district or area is in that part of the state
15 lying within the boundaries of election district 2, 3 or 7, the district
16 or area shall receive 107.50 [103.75] per cent of the base instructional
17 unit allotment;

18 (3) if the district or area is in that part of the state
19 lying within the boundaries of election district 5, 9, 10 or 11, the
20 district or area shall receive 115 [107.50] per cent of the base in-
21 structional unit allotment;

22 (4) if the district or area is in that part of the state
23 lying within the boundaries of election district 16, south of the Arctic
24 Circle, the district or area shall receive 122.50 [111.25] per cent of
25 the base instructional unit allotment;

26 (5) if the district or area is in that part of the state
27 lying within the boundaries of election district 6, the district or area
28 shall receive 130 [115] per cent of the base instructional unit allot-
29 ment;

1 (6) if the district or area is in that part of the state

4 instructional unit allotment;

5 (7) if the district or area is in that part of the state
6 lying within the boundaries of election district 14 or 19 the district
7 or area shall receive 160 [130] per cent of the base instructional unit
8 allotment;

9 (8) if the district or area is in that part of the state
10 lying within the boundaries of election district 15, 16 (north of the
11 Arctic Circle), or 17, the district or area shall receive 167.50 [133.75]
12 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment.

13 * Sec. 3. AS 14.17.051(c) is amended to read:

14 (c) The instructional unit allotment established in (a) of this
15 section for any school district which does not have access to Anchorage,
16 Ketchikan or Fairbanks by road, railroad or Alaska State Ferry System
17 is increased, [SHALL BE INCREASED AN ADDITIONAL FIVE PER CENT] above its
18 instructional unit allotment under (a)(1) - (8) of this section, as
19 follows:

20 (1) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
21 scribed in (a)(1) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
22 increased by an additional 1.875 per cent;

23 (2) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
24 scribed in (a)(2) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
25 increased by an additional 3.750 per cent;

26 (3) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
27 scribed in (a)(3) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
28 increased by an additional 5.625 per cent;

29 (4) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-

1 scribed in (a)(4) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
2 increased by an additional 7.500 per cent;

3 (5) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
4 scribed in (a)(5) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
5 increased by an additional 9.375 per cent;

6 (6) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
7 scribed in (a)(6) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
8 increased by an additional 11.250 per cent;

9 (7) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
10 scribed in (a)(7) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
11 increased by an additional 13.125 per cent;

12 (8) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
13 scribed in (a)(8) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
14 increased by an additional 15.000 per cent.
