6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the appointment and compensation of
7 local registrars and deputy local registrars of vital
8 statistics."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.50.080(a) and (b) are amended to read:

11 (a) Where feasible, the state registrar shall use the services of
12 an employee of the department [A LOCAL RECORDING OFFICIAL] located
13 within a registration district as local registrar of vital statistics.

14 (b) Where utilization under (a) of this section is not feasible,
15 the state registrar shall appoint a local registrar and may appoint one
16 or more deputy local registrars of vital statistics for each registra-
17 tion district, to be compensated on a fee basis as specified in sec. 120
18 of this chapter. The state registrar may, with the approval of the
19 administrative director of the Alaska Court System, appoint magistrates
20 as local registrars and deputy local registrars of vital statistics.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 18.50.120 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 18.50.120. COMPENSATION OF LOCAL REGISTRARS. When an
23 employee of the department or a magistrate [A LOCAL RECORDING OFFICIAL]
24 receiving a salary or other regular compensation from the state [FOR
25 GENERAL RECORDING DUTIES] serves as local registrar or deputy local
26 registrar of vital statistics, he is not entitled to fees under this
27 section. Otherwise, local registrars and deputy local registrars
28 of vital statistics shall be paid, from funds appropriated for this
29 purpose, as follows:

1 (1) for a certificate of birth, death, fetal death, or
2 marriage occurring in his registration district, properly completed and
3 transmitted by him in accordance with the regulations and instructions
4 issued under this chapter, §2;

5 (2) for each monthly report indicating the number of the
6 various vital events which occurred in his registration district,
7 properly made in accordance with the regulations and instructions issued
8 under this chapter, §1.
